## Take Immediate Action

A TIA is a serious warning sign of stroke risk

If you are experiencing any of these symptoms:

Don't ignore them!



Risk of stroke following a TIA is high: 10-20% within 90 days, 50% of these within the first 2 days.



TIA's occur when there is a temporary loss of blood supply to the brain.



Most TIA symptoms last a short time – from 30 seconds to 10 minutes – but can last as long as 24 hours.



If you are experiencing symptoms of a TIA seek medical attention immediately.
